



European Doctoral Program in Career Guidance and Counselling (ECADOC)

European Doctorate Programme in Career Guidance and Counselling is financed from the European Funds. In the programme will take part fifteen Partners from European Union countries. The idea of the programme assumes that 25 doctorate students will take part in the programme. ECADOC was initiated by European Society for Vocational Designing and Career Counselling (ESVDC), and the Network for Innovation in Career Guidance and Counselling in Europe (NICE). The aim of this project is to create a programme enabling doctoral students of career guidance and counselling studies to raise the competences and improving international networks.

In the frame of the programme the Consortium will organize summer schools during which doctoral students will develop their knowledge and research abilities.

Curriculums are created to reflect interdisciplinarity, practical perspectives, and specification of guidance area and counselling.

The project finishes in 2016.
